OUR RESPONSIBILITY TO REPRESENT ISLĀM

Dear brothers and sisters, all demands and prohibitions of the Islam are intended to protect human life, property and dignity. Islam brings people from darkness to light, from astray to hidāya. Hidāya is the greatest favour that can be given to man. Our most important task is to be aware of this favour and to have the knowledge to live our religion in the best way. Dear Muslims, Islam does not only mean 'ibāda; Islam means good akhlāq, it means not misleading others, it means being honest. A Muslim is always warm-hearted, merciful and helpful. Dear community, Islam is perfect, but it is man who has weaknesses. If we do something bad (such as lying or not being honest), it is attributed to Islam. This can create a negative image about our faith and about all Muslims. So let us behave in an exemplary manner and do our best to represent Islam in the best way.
