THE WOMAN IN ISLAM

The Prophet ﷺ described the Muslim as someone from whose hand and tongue people are safe.¹ He showed particular care for women and girls. Dear Muslims, women ought to be free from violence, coercion, and humiliation. Be gentle and merciful towards women. The Prophet ﷺ never raised his hand against a woman. Let us take to heart the following saying of the Prophet ﷺ: **“The most complete among the believers in *īmān* are those with the best character. And the best of you are those who are best to their wives.”**²
