Everything that leads to *zinā*, online or offline, is *ḥarām*. The Qur'ān commands us to keep away from *zinā*. Dear believers, the best measure against *zinā* is marriage. It is a command of Allah ﷻ and a *sunna* of the Prophet ﷺ. Let us make it easy for the youth to marry. May Allah ﷻ protect us from *zinā* and from its pathways. *Āmīn*.
